

Interviewees Needed for Research on Renewable Energy Involvement

What: Interview regarding your experience using or working with renewable energy. The results will help inform my thesis project that aims to study how and why people use renewable energy in Amsterdam. This is part of my Master's program in Social and Cultural Anthropology at Vrije Universiteit.

Why: With the continued negative effects of fossil fuels and generally high costs of energy, renewable energy use offers a promising alternative. This is why I believe it's important to understand how people first get involved with renewable energy, their experience using it, and how they collaborate with others to pursue their energy goals.



How: Interviews will be semi-structured, meaning that there are some pre-planned questions but it is meant to be conversational. Questions will be sent to the participant to review before the interview. Several measures will be taken to ensure data protection, which will be further explained at the interview.

When: Most days of the week and times are possible. The interview itself will last about an hour, but can be shortened if needed.
